- It's easy to relate to money in an unhealthy way:
 - Security
 - o Status
 - o Self-worth
 - Comfort
- Jesus sets a boundary on money: It is not and cannot be more valuable than the kingdom of heaven.
 - A healthy relationship with money is born from treasuring the kingdom of heaven most
- The kingdom of heaven:
 - Is currently not a realm or place but a reign and rule of Jesus in His followers' lives (Luke 17:20-21; John 18:36)
 - Is most valuable and offers:
 - Salvation
 - Living hope
 - Spirit-empowered life
 - Purpose in life and suffering
 - Unconditional love
 - Is open to all who humbly turn from living for themselves to live for Jesus (Matthew 4:17; 5:3)
